DR. BISHOP VANDYKE NOAH

We, the Members of the Newark Municipal Council, proudly take this opportunity to commend Dr. Bishop Vandyke Noah, Founder and Bishop of MRCCI/Vandyke Noah Ministries, on being chosen as the guest preacher at the Save Our Nations "Ministry to the Motherland Service", to be held on Sunday, September 17, 2017. Born on November 14, 1965, in Accra, Ghana, Dr. Bishop Noah obtained a B.A. in Theology from King of Kings College in Jerusalem, Israel. He attended Advanced Theology/Hebrew Interpretation at Jerusalem University in Israel and was awarded an Honorary Ph.D. in Theology. Dr. Bishop Noah's ministry provides religious services in Minneapolis, Minnesota and internationally. Dr. Bishop Noah has published eight books, including "Money Begot Money", "The Theology of the Bible", "The Mystery of Sleeping-Dreams and Interpretation", "Marriage Fix" and "Prayers CD's". Dr. Bishop Noah's career accomplishments include training over 300 pastors and ministers and he currently has over 47 pastors and 35 churches worldwide under his direction. He also serves as a radio host and Executive Producer of "Solution Time Radio". Dr. Bishop Noah holds a number of positions, among them, he is a Board Member of "Africa for Israel", which is an organization that supports the nation of Israel, a volunteer counselor for troubled teens in Dakota County, St. Paul, a Board Member and Chaplain for New Enterprise Holdings, Chaplain for the Minnesota Industrialist Association, President of the Global Administrative Counsel of MRCCI worldwide, Past Middle Eastern Coordinator for Morris Cerullo Ministries, President and CEO of Vandyke Noah Ministries and Founder and Bishop of Miracle Redemption Christian Churches Worldwide.
