**WHEREAS**, an emergency has arisen in Special Item of Appropriation in the amount of \$4,700,000.00, for the Newark Riverfront Pedestrian and Bicycle Access Project and no adequate provision has been made in the 2016 Temporary Budget for the aforesaid purpose and N.J.S.A. 40A: 4-20 provides for the creation of an emergency appropriation for the purpose above-mentioned; and

**WHEREAS**, by Resolution 7R4-d dated October 21, 2015, the City of Newark accepted funds for the Newark Riverfront Pedestrian and Bicycle Access Project in the amount of \$4,700,000.00 for the design, construction and improvement of pedestrian and bicycle connections between Broad Street and McCarter Highway; and

**WHEREAS**, N.J.S.A. 40A: 4-20 provides that the Governing Body, by a two-thirds vote, may make temporary emergency appropriations for any purpose for which appropriations may lawfully be made for the period between the beginning of the current fiscal year and the date of the adoption of the budget for said year; and

**WHEREAS**, emergency appropriation adopted in 2016, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A: 4-20 including this resolution total.....\$6,920,121.00.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NEWARK, NEW JERSEY, THAT:**

1. A temporary emergency appropriation be and the same is hereby made for the following classification:

2. Said emergency appropriation shall be provided for in the 2016 budget.
3. A copy of this resolution shall be filed with the Director of Local Government Services by the City Clerk of the City of Newark.
