WHEREAS, the City of Newark is involved in ongoing Legal Matters and therefore has a need to acquire Legal Services; and

WHEREAS, Legal Services are Professional Services, exempt from the requirement for public bidding, pursuant to the Local Public Contracts Law, <u>N.J.S.A</u>. 40A:11-5(1)(a)(i); and

WHEREAS, the Corporation Counsel of the City of Newark caused to be published on the City of Newark's website, a Notice of Request for Qualifications (RFQ) for Civil Litigation Matters Services on or about September 6, 2023; and

WHEREAS, the City of Newark received a total of thirty (30) proposals in response to the RFQ for Civil Litigation Matters; and

WHEREAS, Ehrlich Petriello Gudin Plaza & Reed P.C., submitted a proposal and it was found based upon price and other factors to be in the best interest of the City of Newark to accept the proposal for the purpose of providing Legal Services concerning Civil Litigation Matters; and

WHEREAS, the City of Newark wishes to enter into a contract with Ehrlich Petriello Gudin Plaza & Reed P.C., to provide Legal Services concerning Civil Litigation Matters, in an amount not to exceed One Hundred Thousand Dollars and Zero Cents (\$100,000.00), for a period of January 1, 2024 through December 31, 2024, which shall cover those existing matters currently being handled by Ehrlich Petriello Gudin Plaza & Reed P.C., as well as new matters that may arise during the contract term; and

WHEREAS, the Local Public Contracts Law (N.J.S.A. 40A:11-1 et seq.) requires that notice of the award of contracts for "Professional Services" without competitive bidding must be published in a local newspaper; and

WHEREAS, this contract is for an amount over \$ \$17,500.00 and is being awarded as a fair and open contract pursuant to <u>N.J.S.A.</u> 19:44A-20.5 and is in compliance with the State Pay-to-Play and the City's Pay-to-Play Ordinance.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NEWARK, NEW JERSEY, THAT:

- 1. The Mayor of the City of Newark and/or his designee, the Corporation Counsel, are authorized on behalf of the City of Newark to execute a contract with Ehrlich Petriello Gudin Plaza & Reed P.C., to provide Legal Services concerning Civil Litigation Matters, in an amount not to exceed One Hundred Thousand Dollars and Zero Cents (\$100,000.00), for the period of January 1, 2024 through December 31, 2024, which shall cover those existing matters currently being handled by Ehrlich Petriello Gudin Plaza & Reed P.C., as well as new matters that may arise during the contract term.
- 2. This contract is being awarded pursuant to the fair and open procedures of the State Pay-to-Play Law (N.J.S.A. 19:44A-20.5) and pursuant to the provisions of the Local Public Contracts Law (N.J.S.A. 40A:11-5(1)(a)(i) and is in compliance with the City's Ordinance on Pay-to-Play.
- 3. Pursuant to N.J.A.C. 5:30-5.5(a), Temporary Budget, attached is the Chief Finance Officer's Certification, which states partial available funds in the amount Twenty-Five Thousand Dollars and Zero Cents (\$25,000.00), are available in the 2024 Temporary Budget, the balance to be provided in the 2024 Adopted Budget. The Certification shall be filed, along with the original Resolution and the executed contract in the Office of the City Clerk.
