WHEREAS, the City of Newark wishes to implement the three (3) year option.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NEWARK, NEW JERSEY, THAT:

1. Khamil S. Bowman, 202-B Court Street, Newark, New Jersey, be and he is hereby appointed Constable for a period of three (3) years effective from the date of the Constable Bond to the

- expiration of the bond, which ever occurs first, in accordance with his application to serve writs, subpoenas and warrants.
- 2. Prior to entering upon the execution of his office and no later than thirty (30) days after the effective date of the appointment, the aforesaid appointee shall submit a Constable Bond, which shall be approved as to form, amount and sufficiency of Surety by Resolution of the Municipal Council.

STATEMENT

This resolution authorizes Khamil S. Bowman to serve as a Constable in the City of Newark, New Jersey, for a period of three (3) years from the date of the Constable Bond to its expiration, whichever occurs first.
