**WHEREAS,** an emergency has arisen in Special Item of Appropriation in the amount of \$376,027.00, for the Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant (JAG) Program and no

provision has been made in the 2021 Temporary Budget for the aforesaid purpose and N.J.S.A. 40A:4-20 provides for the creation of an emergency appropriation for the purpose above-mentioned; and

**WHEREAS,** by Resolution 7R9b, dated June 2, 2021, from the United State Department of Justice, Bureau of Justice Assistance, awarded the City of Newark \$376,027.00 to fund overtime costs to address violent crime to be distributed among several municipalities within Essex County; and

**WHEREAS**, N.J.S.A. 40A:4-20 provides that the Governing Body, by a two-thirds vote, may make temporary emergency appropriations for any purpose for which appropriations may lawfully be made for the period between the beginning of the current fiscal year and the date of the adoption of the budget for said year; and

**WHEREAS,** a Memorandum of Understanding among the participating municipalities, represented by their respective law enforcement Executive, has allocated funding pursuant to the following schedule:

Newark = \$250,006.00 Irvington = \$45,111.00 East Orange = \$42,869.00 Orange = \$28,039.00 West Orange = \$10,002.00; and

**WHEREAS,** temporary emergency appropriation adopted in 2021 pursuant to <u>N.J.S.A.</u> 40A:4-20 including this resolution total......\$342,871,710.36.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NEWARK, NEW JERSEY, THAT:

1. A temporary emergency appropriation be and the same is hereby made for the following classification.


