WHEREAS, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:4-19, the Municipal Council of the City of Newark adopted Resolution #7R1-aa(as) dated December 21, 2011 to provide funds for the period January 1, 2012 to March 31, 2012 and Resolution #7R1-ab dated April 4, 2012 to provide funds from April 1, 2012 to April 30, 2012 and Resolution #7R1-I dated May 16, 2012 to provide funds from May 1, 2012 to May 31, 2012 and TER #28 scheduled for the June 7, 2012 meeting to provide funds from June 1, 2012 to June 30, 2012 until the adoption of the Operating Budget of the City of Newark, New Jersey; and

WHEREAS, additional appropriations will be required from July 1, 2012 to July 31, 2012, until the adoption of the budget; and

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 40A:4-20 provides that the Governing Body by a two-thirds vote may make temporary emergency appropriations for any purpose for which appropriations may lawfully be made for the period between the beginning of the current fiscal year and the date of the adoption of the budget for said year; and
