- January 18 Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr.’s Birthday
- February 12 Lincoln’s Birthday
- February 15 President’s Day/Washington’s Birthday

July 5	Independence Day (Observed)
September 6	Labor Day
October 11	Columbus Day
November 2	Election Day
November 11	Veteran's Day
