WHEREAS, an emergency has arisen in Special Item of Appropriation in the amount of \$3,000,000.00 for the Brick City Peace Collective (BCPC) Grant, and no adequate provision has been made in the 2023 Temporary Budget for the aforesaid purpose, and N.J.S.A. 40A:4-20 provides for the creation of an emergency appropriation for the same; and

WHEREAS, by a Notice of Award dated July 1, 2022 the State of New Jersey, Department of Community Affairs, Division of Housing and Community Resources awarded the City of Newark the Brick City Peace Collective (BCPC) Grant in the amount of \$3,000,000.00 to foster initiatives, programs and opportunities to reduce violence and strengthen relationships between law enforcement and Newark communities; and

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 40A:4-20 provides that the Governing Body, by a two-thirds vote, may make temporary emergency appropriations for any purpose for which appropriations may lawfully be made for the period between the beginning of the current fiscal year and the date of the adoption of the budget for said year; and

WHEREAS, emergency appropriations adopted in 2023 pursuant to <u>N.J.S.A.</u> 40A:4-20, including this Resolution, total \$ 17,923,217.00......

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NEWARK, NEW JERSEY, THAT:

1. A temporary emergency appropriation be and the same is hereby made for the following classification:
