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WHEREAS, the North Jersey Transportation Planning Authority (NJTPA) and the State of New Jersey, Department of Transportation (NJDOT) provides funds for Local Safety Programs; and

WHEREAS, on April 8, 2013, the North Jersey Transportation Planning Authority (NJTPA) invited the City of Newark to submit proposals for the FY 2014 solicitation of the Local Safety and High Risk Rural Roads Program; and

WHEREAS, on May 7, 2013, the City of Newark, Department of Engineering submitted a FY 2014 Local Safety Program Proposal for Broad Street and Tichenor Street/Lincoln Park, and Dr. MLK, Jr. Boulevard and 7th Avenue/Crane Street to the North Jersey Transportation Planning Authority (NJTPA) requesting grant funding in the amount of \$1,000,000.00; and

WHEREAS, as a result of this request, the City of Newark was notified on September 23, 2013 by the North Jersey Transportation Planning Authority (NJTPA), that on September 10, 2013 the North Jersey Transportation Planning Authority (NJTPA) Board of Trustees had approved funding through the FY 2014 Local Safety Program for the Broad Street and Tichenor Street/Lincoln Park, and Dr. MLK, Jr. Boulevard and 7th Avenue/Crane Street, in the amount of \$1,282,897.00; and

WHEREAS, no municipal funds are required for receipt or acceptance of this grant award; and

WHEREAS, upon notification of final authorization of this project from NJDOT, the Director of the Department of Engineering shall submit a copy of the authorization letter and the grant/project agreement to the Corporation Counsel and the Business Administrator for review, approval, and signature.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NEWARK, NEW JERSEY, THAT:

- 1. The Mayor and/or his designee, the Director of the Department of Engineering, are hereby authorized to submit a FY 2014 Local Safety Program to the North Jersey Transportation Planning Authority (NJTPA) requesting grant funding in the amount of \$1,282,897.00.
- 2. The Municipal Council hereby ratifies its authorization of this FY 2014 Local Safety Program from the date of submission to the date of adoption of this authorizing resolution.
- 3. The grant award in the amount of \$1,282,897.00 from the New Jersey Department of Transportation is hereby accepted (a copy of the award letter is attached hereto and made a part hereof).

- 4. The Mayor and/or his designee, the Director of the Department of Engineering, are hereby authorized to enter into and execute grant documents with the New Jersey Department of Transportation to receive and expend the grant award in the amount of \$1,282,897.00, for the Broad Street and Tichenor Street/Lincoln Park, and Dr. MLK Jr. Boulevard and 7th Avenue/Crane Street.
- 5. Upon notification of final authorization of this project, the Director of the Department of Engineering, shall submit a complete copy of the grant/project agreement and any associated documents to both the Corporation Counsel and the Business Administrator for review, approval, and signature.
- 6. No municipal funds are required for receipt or acceptance of this grant award.
- 7. The Director of Engineering shall file a fully-executed copy of the grant award letter, the final authorization letter, and the grant/project agreement in the Office of the City Clerk.

STATEMENT
