WHEREAS, an emergency has arisen in the Special Item of Appropriation in the amount of Four Hundred Ninety-Two Thousand Dollars and Zero Cents (\$492,300.00) for the Ryan White HIV/AIDS - Ending the Epidemic (ETE) Program and no adequate provision has been made in the 2022 Temporary Budget for the aforesaid purpose and N.J.S.A. 40A:4-20 provides for the creation of an emergency appropriation for the purpose above-mentioned; and

WHEREAS, by Award Letter dated January 19, 2022, the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services/Health Resources and Services Administration (HRSA) awarded the City of Newark funds for the Ryan White HIV/AIDS - Ending the Epidemic (ETE) Program for Four Hundred Ninety-Two Thousand Dollars and Zero Cents (\$492,300.00). The aforementioned program will provide funds for the provision of health care and supportive services to the residents of the City of Newark; and

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 40A: 4-20 provides that the Governing Body, by a two-thirds vote, may make temporary emergency appropriations for any purpose for which appropriations may lawfully be made for the period between the beginning of the current fiscal year and the date of the adoption of the budget for said year; and

WHEREAS, emergency appropriation adopted in 2022, pursuant to <u>N.J.S.A.</u> 40A: 4-20 including this Resolution total.................\$ 155,068,988.88.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NEWARK, NEW JERSEY, THAT:

- **1.** The Governing Body by a two-thirds vote of its full membership hereby amends its temporary budget by making the following temporary emergency appropriation:
- **2.** A temporary emergency appropriation be and the same is hereby made for the following classification.
