WHEREAS, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:4-19 the Municipal Council of the City of Newark, New Jersey, adopted Resolution # 7R1g-010512 dated January 5, 2012, to provide temporary funds for the period of January 1, 2012 to March 31, 2012, and Resolution # 7R1-ah dated April 4, 2012 to provide temporary funds for the period of April 1, 2012 to April 30, 2012, and Resolution # S3 dated April 3, 2012 to be considered and adopted at its scheduled meeting on May 16, 2012, to provide funds for the period of May 1, 2012 to May 31, 2012, Resolution # S5 dated April 26, 2012 to be considered and adopted at its scheduled meeting on June 7, 2012 to provide funds for the period of June 1, 2012 to June 30, 2012, until the adoption of the Operating Budget of the City of Newark, New Jersey; and

WHEREAS, additional appropriations will be required for the Sewer Utility from July 1, 2012 to July 31, 2012, until the adoption of the budget; and

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 40A: 4-20 provides that the Governing Body by a two-thirds vote may make temporary emergency appropriations for any purpose for which appropriations may lawfully be made for the period between the beginning of the current fiscal year and the date of the adoption of the budget for said year; and

WHEREAS, the emergency appropriations adopted in 2012, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A: 4-20 including this resolution total.....\$41,196,252.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NEWARK, NEW JERSEY, THAT:

1. The Governing Body by a two-thirds vote of its full membership hereby amends its temporary budget by making the following temporary emergency appropriations for the Sewer Utility:
