**WHEREAS**, an emergency has arisen in the Special Item of Appropriation in the amount of Seven Hundred Thousand and Zero Cents (\$700,000.00) for initiatives to address gun crimes and no adequate provision has been made in the 2023 Temporary Budget for the aforesaid purpose and N.J.S.A. 40A:4-20 provides for the creation of an emergency appropriation for the purpose above-mentioned; and

**WHEREAS**, by the Notice of Award dated September 29, 2022, the United States Department of Justice, Office of Justice Programs, Bureau of Justice Assistance awarded the City of Newark funds in the amount of \$700,000.00. The aforementioned program will provide funds for the initiatives to address gun crimes; and

**WHEREAS**, N.J.S.A. 40A:4-20 provides that the Governing Body, by a two-thirds vote, may make temporary emergency appropriations for any purpose for which appropriations may lawfully be made for the period between the beginning of the current fiscal year and the date of the adoption of the budget for said year; and

**WHEREAS**, emergency appropriation adopted in 2023, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:4-20 including this Resolution total.....\$ 512,471,092.40.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NEWARK, NEW JERSEY, THAT:**

1. The Governing Body by a two-thirds vote of its full membership hereby amends its temporary budget by making the following temporary emergency appropriation:
2. A temporary emergency appropriation be and the same is hereby made for the following classification.

3. The temporary emergency appropriation shall be provided for in the 2023 budget.
4. A copy of this Resolution shall be filed with the Director of Local Government Services by the City Clerk.

This Resolution establishes the temporary emergency appropriation for the initiatives to address gun crimes Grant, in the amount of Seven Hundred Thousand and Zero Cents (\$700,000.00). The United States Department of Justice, Bureau of Justice Assistance awarded the funds. The project period is October 1, 2022 through September 30, 2025.
