**WHEREAS**, an emergency has arisen in the Special Item of Appropriation in the amount of Three Hundred Eighty-Three Thousand Seven Hundred Fifty-Two Dollars and Zero Cents (\$383,752.00) for the Division of Public Health Infrastructure, Laboratories and Emergency Preparedness (PHILEP), Program and no adequate provision has been made in the 2023 Temporary Budget for the aforesaid purpose and N.J.S.A. 40A:4-20 provides for the creation of an emergency appropriation for the purpose above-mentioned; and

**WHEREAS**, by the Notice of Award dated April 26, 2023, the New Jersey Department of Health, Division of PHILEP awarded the City of Newark funds in the amount of \$383,752.00. The aforementioned program will provide funds for the provision of health care and supportive services to the residents of the City of Newark; and

**WHEREAS**, N.J.S.A. 40A:4-20 provides that the Governing Body, by a two-thirds vote, may make temporary emergency appropriations for any purpose for which appropriations may lawfully be made for the period between the beginning of the current fiscal year and the date of the adoption of the budget for said year; and

**WHEREAS**, emergency appropriation adopted in 2023, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A: 4-20 including this Resolution total.....\$444,363,430.43.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NEWARK, NEW JERSEY, THAT:**

1. The Governing Body by a two-thirds vote of its full membership hereby amends its temporary budget by making the following temporary emergency appropriation:
2. A temporary emergency appropriation be and the same is hereby made for the following classification.
