WHEREAS, an emergency has arisen in Special Item of Appropriation in the amount of \$273,033.00 for the Homeless Health Care Project - Primary Care HIV Prevention (PCHP) Grant and no adequate provision has been made in the 2022 Temporary Budget for the aforesaid purpose, and <u>N.J.S.A.</u> 40A:4-20 provides for the creation of an emergency appropriation for the same; and

WHEREAS, by the award letter dated February 11, 2022, the United States Department of Health and Human Services, Health Resources and Services Administration (HRSA) has awarded the City of Newark the Homeless Health Care Project - Primary Care HIV Prevention (PCHP) Grant in the amount of \$273,033.00. The aforementioned program focus is to improve access to ending the HIV Epidemic in the City of Newark; and

WHEREAS, <u>N.J.S.A.</u> 40A:4-20 provides that the Governing Body, by a two-thirds vote, may make temporary emergency appropriations for any purpose for which appropriations may lawfully be made for the period between the beginning of the current fiscal year and the date of the adoption of the budget for said year; and

WHEREAS, emergency appropriations adopted in 2022, pursuant to <u>N.J.S.A.</u> 40A:4-20, including this Resolution, total \$224,069,918.61.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NEWARK, NEW JERSEY, THAT:
