**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE XXIII, TRAFFIC, CHAPTER 3, PROHIBITED TURNS, SECTION 23:3-5, NO TURNS ON RED, OF THE REVISED GENERAL ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF NEWARK, NEW JERSEY, 2000, AS AMENDED AND SUPPLEMENTED, BY PROHIBITING RIGHT TURNS ON RED AT THE INTERSECTION OF FRELINGHUYSEN AVENUE AND EAST PEDDIE STREET (SOUTH WARD).**  
**No Action Taken 8-a 111323**

**WHEREAS**, the Department of Engineering, Division of Traffic and Signals, has determined that the intersection of Frelinghuysen Avenue and East Peddie Street in the South Ward qualifies for a “No Turn on Red” designation, in accordance with the Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices; and

**WHEREAS**, such designation will improve safety and avoid conflicts with trains at the Conrail railroad crossing that is located in close proximity to the intersection; and

**WHEREAS**, the Division of Traffic and Signals desires to improve safety at the signalized intersection of Frelinghuysen Avenue and East Peddie Street, in the South Ward by prohibiting right turn on red at all approaches.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF**

**NEWARK, NEW JERSEY, THAT:**

**Section 1.** Title 23, Traffic and Parking, Section 23:3-5, No Turns on Red, of the Revised General Ordinances of the City of Newark, New Jersey, 2000, as amended and supplemented, be amended by adding thereto the following:

Intersection  
**Frelinghuysen and East Peddie Street**

Right Turn Prohibition  
**All right turns**

**Section 2.** Any existing Ordinances or parts thereof inconsistent with this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

**Section 3.** This Ordinance shall take effect upon final passage and publication and in accordance with the laws of the State of New Jersey.

**Section 4.** This Ordinance does not require approval by the Commissioner of Transportation.

**Section 5. Codification.** This Ordinance shall be a part of the Code of the City of Newark as though codified and fully set forth therein. The City Clerk shall have this Ordinance codified and incorporated in the official copies of the Code. The City Clerk and the Corporation Counsel are authorized and directed to change any Chapter, Article and/or Section number of the Code of the City of Newark in the event that the codification of this Ordinance reveals that there is a conflict between the numbers and the existing Code, and in order to avoid confusion and possible accidental repealers of existing provisions not intended to be repealed.

**STATEMENT**

This Ordinance authorizes the Department of Engineering, Division of Traffic and Signals, to improve safety at the signalized intersection of Frelinghuysen Avenue and East Peddie Street, in the South Ward, by prohibiting vehicles from making a right turn when facing a steady red signal indication at the intersection of Frelinghuysen and East Peddie Street at all approaches, whenever an official sign is present prohibiting such a turn on the red.
