**WHEREAS**, an emergency has arisen in Special Item of Appropriation in the amount of One Million Two Hundred Twenty-Eight Thousand One Hundred Forty-Eight Dollars and Zero Cents (\$1,228,148.00) for The Natural Climate Solutions Grants "Newark Canopy Initiative", and no adequate provision has been made in the 2024 Temporary Budget for the aforesaid purpose, and N.J.S.A. 40A:4-20 provides for the creation of an emergency appropriation for the same; and

**WHEREAS,** by the award letter dated September 28, 2023, New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection (NJDEP) has awarded the City of Newark, The Natural Climate Solutions Grants "Newark Canopy Initiative" funding of \$1,228,148.00; and

**WHEREAS**, N.J.S.A. 40A:4-20 provides that the Governing Body, by a two-thirds vote, may make temporary emergency appropriations for any purpose for which appropriations may lawfully be made for the period between the beginning of the current fiscal year and the date of the adoption of the budget for said year; and

**WHEREAS,** emergency appropriations adopted in 2024, pursuant to <u>N.J.S.A.</u> 40A:4-20, including this Resolution, total ......\$114,445,328.66.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NEWARK, NEW JERSEY, THAT:

1. A temporary emergency appropriation be and the same is hereby made for the following classification:
