**WHEREAS**, an emergency has arisen in Special Item of Appropriation in the amount of \$375,175.00 for the Hazardous Site Remediation Fund Grant Program and no adequate provision has been made in the 2012 Temporary Budget for the aforesaid purpose; and

**WHEREAS**, by Resolution# 7R3b dated April 6, 2011 from the New Jersey Economic Development Authority (NJEDA) through the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection (NJDEP), the City of Newark was awarded \$375,175.00 for the Hazardous Discharge Site Remediation Fund Grant Program for the property located at 411 Wilson Avenue: and

**WHEREAS**, N.J.S.A 40A:4-20 provides that the Governing Body by a two-thirds vote may make temporary emergency appropriations for any purpose for which appropriations may lawfully be made for the period between the beginning of the current fiscal year and the date of the adoption of the budget for said year; and

**WHEREAS**, emergency appropriation adopted in 2012 pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:4-20 including this resolution total...\$148,830,151.63.
