WHEREAS, an emergency has arisen in the Special Item of Appropriation in the amount of Nine Hundred Thirteen Thousand, Four Hundred Twenty-Eight Dollars and Zero Cents (\$913,428.00), for the Ryan White HIV/AIDS Program Ending the HIV Epidemic (ETE) and no adequate provision has been made in the 2024 Temporary Budget for the aforesaid purpose and N.J.S.A. 40A:4-20 provides for the creation of an emergency appropriation for the purpose above-mentioned; and

WHEREAS, by the Notice of Award dated January 30, 2024, the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services/Health Resources and Services Administration (HRSA) awarded the City of Newark funds in the amount of Nine Hundred Thirteen Thousand, Four Hundred Twenty-Eight Dollars and Zero Cents (\$913,428.00) for the provision of Ending the HIV Epidemic. The aforementioned program will provide funds for the provision of health care and supportive services to the residents of the City of Newark; and

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 40A: 4-20 provides that the Governing Body, by a two-thirds vote, may make temporary emergency appropriations for any purpose for which appropriations may lawfully be made for the period between the beginning of the current fiscal year and the date of the adoption of the budget for said year; and

WHEREAS, emergency appropriation adopted in 2024, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A: 4-20

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NEWARK, NEW JERSEY, THAT:

1. The Governing Body by a two-thirds vote of its full membership hereby amends its temporary budget by making the following temporary emergency appropriation:

STATEMENT

This Resolution establishes the temporary emergency appropriation for the Ryan White HIV/AIDS Part ETE Program FY 2024, in the amount of Nine Hundred Thirteen Thousand, Four Hundred Twenty-Eight Dollars and Zero Cents (\$913,428.00). The U.S. Department of Health and Human Services/Health Resources and Services Administration awarded the funds. The project period is March 1, 2024 through February 28, 2025.
