**WHEREAS**, Khary Orr was employed in a number of positions including as an employee of the City of Newark as a Project Coordinator; and

**WHEREAS**, Khary Orr departed this life at an early age leaving behind a host of family members and friends along with a son known as Khari Black-Orr; and

**WHEREAS**, Kharey Orr was an active member of Union Chapel AME Church where he served as an Acolyte and YTD President; and

**WHEREAS**, the residents of the City of Newark, New Jersey is seeking to have the name of Khary Orr memorialized for all residents to honor on his behalf; and

**WHEREAS**, the Municipal Council of the City of Newark wishes to designate the corner of Eckert Avenue and Seymour Avenue as the Khary Orr Plaza for ceremonial and honorary purposes.
