**WHEREAS**, an emergency has arisen in the Special Item of Appropriation in the amount of \$89,113.00 for the Sexually Transmitted Diseases (STD) Program and no provision has been made in the 2018 Temporary Budget for the aforesaid purpose and N.J.S.A. 40A:4-20 provides for the creation of an emergency appropriation for the purpose above-mentioned; and

**WHEREAS**, by award letter dated August 17, 2017, from the New Jersey Department of Health and Senior Services, the City of Newark has been awarded \$89,113.00 to provide sexually transmitted diseases outreach and educational services to include but not limited to medical and laboratory services for residents within the City of Newark; and

**WHEREAS**, N.J.S.A. 40A:4-20 provides that the Governing Body by a two-thirds vote may make temporary emergency appropriations for any purpose for which appropriations may lawfully be made for the period between the beginning of the current fiscal year and the date of the adoption of the budget for said year; and

**WHEREAS**, emergency appropriation adopted in 2018, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:4-20 including this resolution total.....\$ 72,080,317.15

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NEWARK, NEW JERSEY, THAT:**

1. A temporary emergency appropriation be and the same is hereby made for the
