WHEREAS, an emergency has arisen in the Special Item of Appropriation in the amount of Ninety Thousand Dollars and Zero Cents (\$90,000.00), for the NJ COVID-19 Supplemental Grant Program and no adequate provision has been made in the 2023 Temporary Budget for the aforesaid purpose and <u>N.J.S.A.</u> 40A:4-20 provides for the creation of an emergency appropriation for the purpose above-mentioned; and

WHEREAS, by the Notice of Award dated May 22, 2023, the New Jersey Department of Health and Human Services, awarded the City of Newark funds in the amount of Ninety Thousand Dollars and Zero Cents (\$90,000.00). The aforementioned program will provide funds for continued COVID-19 integration of vaccination, educational outreach and expand and ensure equitable distribution across the jurisdiction, including among high-risk and underserved populations.; and

WHEREAS, <u>N.J.S.A.</u> 40A: 4-20 provides that the Governing Body, by a two-thirds vote, may make temporary emergency appropriations for any purpose for which appropriations may lawfully be made for the period between the beginning of the current fiscal year and the date of the adoption of the budget for said year; and

WHEREAS, total emergency appropriations adopted in 2023, pursuant to <u>N.J.S.A.</u> 40A: 4-20 including this Resolution total......\$451,328,059.43.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NEWARK, NEW JERSEY, THAT:

- **1.** The Governing Body by a two-thirds vote of its full membership hereby amends its temporary budget by making the following temporary emergency appropriation:
