WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution 7R3-e adopted on July 1 2015, the Municipal Council authorized the Deputy Mayor/Director of the Department of Economic and Housing Development on behalf of the Business Administrator and the City of Newark to enter into and execute a Sub-recipient Agreement with St. James Social Service Corporation, for the purpose of providing Public Facilities Development/Rehabilitation services to its facility located at 604-606 Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. Boulevard/Block 103, Lot 60 (Central Ward), in an amount not to exceed Twenty-Eight Thousand, Four Hundred Sixty Dollars and Zero Cents (\$28,460.00)); and

**WHEREAS,** the Sub-recipient has requested authorization to extend the expiration date of the Agreement from December 31, 2015, to June 30, 2016 to allow the Sub-recipient to complete the renovation to the above facility; and

**WHEREAS**, the Agreement may be extended for up to two (2) 6-month periods, provided that any such extension is at no additional cost to the City, is authorized by Resolution of the Newark Municipal Council including a finding that the services are being performed in an effective and efficient manner, and is in writing and signed by both parties; and

**WHEREAS**, the Deputy Mayor/Director of the Department of Economic Housing and Development desires to exercise one of its 6-month extensions to extend Sub-recipient Agreement

for six months from December 31, 2015 to June 30, 2016; and

**WHEREAS**, this project does not require the use of additional funds and all other terms and conditions contained in Sub-recipient Agreement authorized under Resolution 7R3-e July 1, 2015 shall remain the same.

## NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NEWARK, NEW JERSEY, THAT:

- 1. The Mayor and/or his designee, the Deputy Mayor/Director of the Department of Economic and Housing Development, are hereby authorized to enter into and execute an Amended Subrecipient Agreement for 6-months from December 31, 2015 through June 30, 2016, to allow the St. James Social Service Corporation to complete the Public Facilities Development/Rehabilitation to its facility, 604-606 Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. Boulevard/Block 103, Lot 60 (Central Ward).
- 2. The contract extension is hereby ratified from December 31, 2015 to the date of adoption of this authorizing resolution.
- 3. This resolution and a fully executed copy of the First Amended Sub-recipient Agreement shall be filed with the Office of the City Clerk by the Deputy Mayor/Director of the Department of Economic and Housing Development.
- 4. The Agreement may be extended for one final 6-month extension, pursuant to Resolution 7R3-e, adopted on July 1, 2015; provided that any such extension is at no additional cost to the City, is authorized by Resolution of the Newark Municipal Council including a finding that the services are being performed in an effective and efficient manner, and is in writing and signed by both parties.
- 5. This project does not require the use of additional funds and all other terms and conditions contained in the Sub-recipient Agreement authorized pursuant to Resolution 7R3-e, adopted by the Municipal Council on July 1, 2015 shall remain the same.
