**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Resolution 7R1A(S), authorized on January 11, 2011, the City of Newark appropriated \$100,650.00 in Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funds to Youth Build Newark, (hereinafter referred to as the Sub-recipient) to provide physical rehabilitation services to its facility located at 646-650 Fifteenth Avenue, Newark, NJ; and

**WHEREAS,** pursuant to Resolution 7R1-F, authorized on May 18, 2011, the Municipal Council authorized the Mayor and/or his designee, the Deputy Mayor/Director of the Department of Economic and Housing Development to enter into and execute contract with the sub-recipient for the purpose of performing physical rehabilitation to its facility located at 646-650 Fifteenth Avenue, Newark, NJ, Block 24, Lot 56/West, for the contract period January 1, 2011 - December 31, 2011, in an amount not to exceed \$100,650.00; and

**WHEREAS**, the Sub-recipient has requested authorization to extend the contract period to complete this project from January 1, 2011-December 31, 2011 to January 1, 2011-December 31, 2012; and

**WHEREAS**, this project does not require the use of additional funds and all other terms and conditions contained in the contract authorized under Resolution 7R1-F051811 shall remain in full effect.

- 1. The Mayor and/or his designee, the Deputy Mayor/Director of the Department of Economic and Housing Development, are hereby authorized to enter into and execute a First Amended Agreement, in the form attached hereto, with Youth Build Newark, (hereafter referred to as the Sub-recipient) which will amend the term of the contract from January 1, 2011-December 31, 2011 to January 1, 2011-December 31, 2012, to allow the sub-recipient to complete the revised physical rehabilitation to its facility located at 646-650 Fifteenth Avenue, Newark, NJ, Block 24, Lot 56/West..
- 2. The First Amended Agreement between the City of Newark and the sub-recipient is hereby ratified from January 1, 2011 to the date of adoption of this authorizing resolution.
