Resolution 7R1-a adopted on November 15, 2021, authorized the application/acceptance of the One

WHEREAS, the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) has approved a total allocation of \$16,659,111.00 to the City of Newark by an approval notice dated September 10, 2021, and on November 15, 2021, pursuant to Resolution 7R1-a, the Municipal Council authorized the Mayor of the City of Newark and Business Administrator to file a new consolidated plan with HUD, which contains a request for Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funds in the amount \$7,526,667.00, HOME funds in the amount \$2,739,395.00 Housing Opportunities for People with AIDS (HOPWA) in the amount of \$5,768,156.00 (on behalf of Newark and the "Eligible Metropolitan Area"), and Emergency Solutions Grant funds in the amount of \$624,893.00, in compliance with Federal statutes and regulations governing the four aid grant programs; and

Year Action Plan for Program Year 2021-2022, which included \$7,526,667.00 of CDBG funds.

WHEREAS, Resolution 7R1-a adopted on November 15, 2021, further authorized the Mayor of the City of Newark and the Business Administrator to enter into four (4) separate agreements with HUD to receive and expend FY 2021 Community Development Block Grant funds in the amount of \$7,526,667.00, HOME funds in the amount \$2,739,395.00 Housing Opportunities for People with AIDS (HOPWA) in the amount of \$5,768,156.00 (on behalf of Newark and the "Eligible Metropolitan Area"), and Emergency Solutions Grant funds in the amount of \$624,893.00; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Newark desires to establish the block grant program and appropriate the funds to the various sub-grantees.
