**WHEREAS**, an emergency has arisen in Special Item of Appropriation in the amount of Two Hundred Sixty-Four Thousand Eight Hundred Ninety-Six Dollars and Seventy Cents (\$264,896.70) for 2020 Recycling Tonnage Grant and no provision has been made in the 2023 Temporary Budget for the aforesaid purpose and N.J.S.A. 40A:4-20 provides for the creation of an emergency appropriation for the purpose above-mentioned; and

**WHEREAS**, under separate cover Apply and Accept Resolution (Legistar File ID #23-0387) is submitted by the Department of Public Works to accept the 2020 Recycling Tonnage Grant in the amount of Two Hundred Sixty-Four Thousand Eight Hundred Ninety-Six Dollars and Seventy Cents (\$264,896.70) from the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection, to encourage local source separation and recycling programs within the municipality; and

**WHEREAS**, N.J.S.A. 40A:4-20 provides that the Governing Body by a two-thirds vote may make temporary emergency appropriations for any purpose for which appropriations may lawfully be made for the period between the beginning of the current fiscal year and the date of the adoption of the budget for said year; and

**WHEREAS**, emergency appropriation adopted in 2023, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:4-20 including this Resolution total..... \$162,381,062.93.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CITY**

**OF NEWARK, NEW JERSEY, THAT:**

1. A temporary emergency appropriation be and the same is hereby made for the following classification;
