**WHEREAS**, the City of Newark provides sexually transmitted diseases outreach, educational and medical services, including, but not limited to, high quality medical and laboratory services, to residents of the City of Newark at the City's Communicable Disease Prevention and Treatment Center (CDPTC); and

**WHEREAS**, the New Jersey Department of Health and Senior Services has made grant funds available for the provision of such services at the CDPTC; and

**WHEREAS**, on April 20, 2016, on behalf of the City of Newark, the Director of the Department of Health and Community Wellness submitted an application to the New Jersey Department of Health and Senior Services, P.O. Box 360, Trenton, New Jersey 08625, requesting grant funding in the amount of one hundred twenty-four thousand, one hundred thirteen dollars and zero cents (\$124,113.00), for the continued provision of sexually transmitted diseases outreach, educational and medical services for the period commencing on July 1, 2016, and terminating on June 30, 2017 (a copy of the Grant Application is attached hereto and made a part hereof); and

**WHEREAS**, as a result of this application, on August 30, 2016, the City of Newark was awarded a grant in the amount of one hundred twenty-four thousand, one hundred thirteen dollars and zero cents (\$124,113.00) from the New Jersey Department of Health and Senior Services, for the period commencing on July 1, 2016, and terminating on June 30, 2017 (a copy of the Notice of Grant Award is attached hereto and made a part hereof); and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Newark, Department of Health and Community Wellness, desires to

accept the awarded grant funds in the amount of one hundred twenty-four thousand, one hundred thirteen dollars and zero cents (\$124,113.00); and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Newark recognizes that the New Jersey Department of Health and Senior Services may extend the time of the grant award and/or provide additional funds if made available; and

**WHEREAS**, in such cases, the New Jersey Department of Health and Senior Services will amend the grant to reflect the grant time extension and/or increase or decrease of grant funds as applicable; and

**WHEREAS**, in such cases, the City of Newark's Department of Health and Community Wellness shall, upon any such extension of time of the grant and/or increase or decrease of grant funds, file with the City of Newark Municipal Council for their consideration a proposed amending resolution reflecting the final term and award amount of the grant; and

**WHEREAS**, the terms of this grant award may only be waived or amended by the parties duly authorized to execute the grant, subject to the approval of the Newark Municipal Council by resolution.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NEWARK, NEW JERSEY, THAT:**

1. The Mayor and/or his designee, the Director of the Department of Health and Community Wellness, are hereby authorized to submit an application to the New Jersey Department of Health and Senior Services, P.O. Box 360, Trenton, New Jersey 08625, requesting funds in the amount of one hundred twenty-four thousand, one hundred thirteen dollars and zero cents (\$124,113.00), in order to provide sexually transmitted diseases outreach, educational and medical services, including, but not limited to, high quality medical and laboratory services, to residents of the City of Newark at the City's Communicable Disease Prevention and Treatment Center for the period commencing on July 1, 2016, and terminating on June 30, 2017.
2. The Municipal Council hereby ratifies its authorization of this application from the date of the application's submission to the date of adoption of this authorizing resolution.
3. The grant award in the amount of one hundred twenty-four thousand, one hundred thirteen dollars and zero cents (\$124,113.00) from the New Jersey Department of Health and Senior Services, is hereby accepted.
4. The Mayor and/or his designee, the Director of the Department of Health and Community Wellness, are hereby authorized to receive and expend the grant award for the continued provision of sexually transmitted diseases outreach, educational and medical services, for the period commencing on July 1, 2016, and terminating on June 30, 2017.
5. The City of Newark's Department of Health and Community Wellness shall, upon any extension of the time of the grant and/or increase or decrease of grant funds, file with the City of Newark's Municipal Council for their consideration, a proposed amending resolution reflecting the final time and award amount of the grant.

6. The Municipal Council hereby ratifies the acceptance of this grant award from July 1, 2016, to the date of adoption of this authorizing resolution.
7. No municipal funds are required for receipt or acceptance of this grant award.

### **STATEMENT**

This resolution ratifies and authorizes the actions taken by the Mayor and/or his designee, the Director of the Department of Health and Community Wellness, to apply for and accept grant funds in the amount of One Hundred Twenty-Four Thousand, One Hundred Thirteen Dollars and Zero Cents (\$124,113.00), from the New Jersey Department of Health and Senior Services, to provide sexually transmitted diseases outreach, educational and medical services, for the period commencing on July 1, 2016, and terminating on June 30, 2017, at the City's Communicable Disease Prevention and Treatment Center. No municipal funds are required for the acceptance of the grant funds.
