WHEREAS, the State of New Jersey Department of Transportation (NJDOT) has designated

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certain roadways in New Jersey as Safe Corridors based upon accident rates, fatalities, traffic volume and other criteria; and

**WHEREAS**, a portion of Route 22 in the City of Newark has been designated as a Safe Corridor by the State Department of Transportation; and

**WHEREAS,** the NJDOT has appropriated funds under the FY 2012 Highway Safety Fund Grant Program to local law enforcement efforts by municipalities responsible for these Safe Corridors; and

**WHEREAS,** the NJDOT has identified the City of Newark, New Jersey's Police Department to be an eligible recipient of up to \$3,199.70 in FY 2012 Highway Safety Fund Grant Program; and

**WHEREAS,** on October 5, 2012, on behalf of the City of Newark, the Police Director submitted an application to the State of New Jersey Department of Transportation (NJDOT) requesting grant funding in the amount of \$3,199.70 from the FY 2012 Highway Safety Fund Grant Program for reimbursement funding for two (2) Stalker II Stationary radar units used for traffic enforcement in the City's Safe Corridor Zone with no municipal funds required; and

**WHEREAS,** as a result of this application, the City of Newark has been awarded a grant award in the amount of \$3,199.70 from the State of New Jersey Department of Transportation (NJDOT) for reimbursement funding for two (2) Stalker II Stationary radar units used for traffic enforcement in the City's Safe Corridor Zone with no municipal funds required for the period commencing on August 1, 2012 and terminating on July 31, 2013.

## NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NEWARK, NEW JERSEY, THAT:

- 1. The Mayor and/or his designee, the Police Director, are hereby authorized to submit an application to the State of New Jersey Department of Transportation (NJDOT) requesting grant funding in the amount of \$3,199.70 from the FY 2012 Highway Safety Fund Grant Program for reimbursement funding for two (2) Stalker II Stationary radar units used for traffic enforcement in the City's Safe Corridor Zone with no municipal funds required (a copy of the application is attached hereto and made a part hereof).
- **2.** The Municipal Council hereby ratifies its authorization of this application from the date of application submission to the date of adoption of this authorizing resolution.
- **3.** The grant award in the amount of \$3,199.70 from the State of New Jersey Department of Transportation (NJDOT) is hereby accepted (a copy of the award letter is attached hereto and made a part hereof).
- **4.** The Mayor and/or his designee, the Police Director, are hereby authorized to enter into and execute grant documents with the State of New Jersey Department of Transportation (NJDOT) to receive and expend the grant award in the amount of \$3,199.70 for

reimbursement funding for two (2) Stalker II Stationary radar units used for traffic enforcement in the City's Safe Corridor Zone, for the period commencing on August 1, 2012 and terminating on July 31, 2013.

- **5.** The agreement between the City of Newark and the State of New Jersey Department of Transportation (NJDOT) is hereby ratified from August 1, 2012 to the date of adoption of this authorizing resolution.
- **6.** No municipal funds are required for receipt or acceptance of this grant award.
- **7.** The Police Director shall file a fully-executed copy of the grant application, the grant award letter, and the grant agreement in the Office of City Clerk.

## <u>STATEMENT</u>

This resolution ratifies and authorizes the Mayor and/or his designee, the Police Director and the actions taken to submit an application for grant funding from New Jersey Department of Transportation under the FY2012 Highway Safety Fund Grant Program and to enter into and execute an agreement with and accept grant funds in the amount of \$3,199.70 from the New Jersey Department of Transportation for reimbursement funding for two (2) Stalker II Stationary radar units used for traffic enforcement in the City's Safe Corridor Zone for the period commencing on August 1, 2012 and terminating on July 31, 2013. No municipal funds are required.
