WHEREAS, an emergency has arisen in Special Item of Appropriation in the amount of \$500,000.00 for the FY 2013 Local Safety Program - Broad Street and South Street Pedestrian Safety Project (Citywide) and no adequate provision has been made in the 2013 Temporary Budget for the aforesaid purpose and N.J.S.A. 40A: 4-20 provides for the creation of an emergency appropriation for the purpose above-mentioned; and

WHEREAS, by award letter dated December 4, 2012, from the North Jersey Transportation Planning Authority, the City of Newark has been awarded \$500,000.00 for the FY 2013 Local Safety Program - Broad Street and South Street Pedestrian Safety Project; and

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 40A: 4-20 provides that the Governing Body by a two-thirds vote may make temporary emergency appropriations for any purpose for which appropriations may lawfully be made for the period between the beginning of the current fiscal year and the date of the adoption of the budget for said year; and

WHEREAS, emergency appropriation adopted in 2013, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A: 4-20 including this resolution total.....\$110,219,368.97.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NEWARK, NEW JERSEY, THAT:

1. A temporary emergency appropriation be and the same is hereby made for the following classification.
