WHEREAS, N.J.S.A 40A: 4-87 provides that the Director of Local Government Services may approve the insertion of any Special Item of Revenue in the budget of any local unit when such item shall have been made available by law and the amount thereof shall not have been determined at the time of the adoption of the budget, and may approve the insertion of an appropriation item of equal amount for the purpose of carrying out the purposes of the law making such item of revenue available for expenditure; and

WHEREAS, by Resolution 7R1-j dated September 18, 2013, the City of Newark accepted the Emergency Solutions Grant (ESG) in the amount of \$483,211.00 to provide shelters for homeless individuals and/or indigent families in the City of Newark ; and

WHEREAS, the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development has made available \$483,211.00 for the Emergency Solutions Grant (ESG) (Citywide).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NEWARK, NEW JERSEY, THAT:

1. In accordance with the provisions of N.J.S.A 40A: 4-87, the City of Newark, New Jersey, hereby requests the Director of Local Government Services to approve a budget insertion in the amount of \$483,211.00 and an appropriation of an equal amount for the Emergency Solutions Grant (ESG) in the budget year 2013 as set forth in Schedule A, attached hereto and made a part hereof.
2. That the aforesaid insertion is, in the opinion of the Governing Body, warranted and authorized by N.J.S.A. 40A: 4-87 and is necessary for the orderly operation of the municipality.
3. A copy of this resolution shall be filed with the Director of the Division of Local Government Services by the City Clerk of the City of Newark.

STATEMENT

This resolution establishes the revenue and appropriation in the 2013 Municipal Budget in the amount of \$483,211.00 for the Emergency Solutions Grant (ESG) city-wide. The United States Department of Housing and Urban Development are providing these funds. The project period is September 1, 2013 through August 31, 2014.
