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**WHEREAS**, the City of Newark is involved in ongoing legal matters and therefore has a need to acquire legal services; and

WHEREAS, the City of Newark issued a Request for Qualifications for Legal Services

concerning Litigation Defense Matters on or about September 17, 2012; and

**WHEREAS**, legal services are professional services and are exempt from the requirements for public bidding pursuant to the Local Public Contracts Law, more specifically, N.J.S.A. 40A:11-5(1)(a) (i); and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Newark by Resolution 7R7-h adopted on February 6, 2013 awarded a contract to Hardin, Kundla, McKeon & Poletto, with offices located at 673 Morris Avenue, Springfield, New Jersey 07081-0730, to provide legal services concerning Litigation Defense Matters in an amount not to exceed One Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$150,000.00), for the period of January 1, 2013 through December 31, 2013; and

**WHEREAS,** increased and unforeseen activity in matters assigned to Hardin, Kundla, McKeon & Poletto necessitates increasing the contract amount by \$35,000.00, so that the total contract amount will be an amount not to exceed \$185,000.00; and

**WHEREAS,** the Local Public Contracts Law (N.J.S.A. 40A:11-1 et seq.) requires that notice of the award of contracts for "Professional Services" without competitive bidding must be published in a local newspaper; and

**WHEREAS**, this contract amendment was awarded as a non-fair and open contract pursuant to N.J.S.A. 19:44A-20.5; and

**WHEREAS**, the Mayor of the City of Newark signed into law Executive Order Number MEO-07-0001 (hereinafter "Pay-to-Play Executive Order") and the Contractor Pay-to-Play Reform Ordinance, 6PSF-a, August 12, 2012, which requires reporting of political contributions to Newark Municipal and/or County of Essex Candidates and prohibits certain political contributions during the duration of the contract.

## NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NEWARK, NEW JERSEY, THAT:

- 1. The Mayor and/or his designee, the Corporation Counsel, are hereby authorized and directed on behalf of the City of Newark to execute an Amended Contract with Hardin, Kundla, McKeon & Poletto, to provide legal services concerning Litigation Defense Matters, as necessary for an additional \$35,000.00 which would result in a total amount not to exceed One Hundred Eighty-Five Thousand Dollars (\$185,000.00), for the period of January 1, 2013 through December 31, 2013, which shall cover those existing matters currently being handled by Hardin, Kundla, McKeon & Poletto, as well as new matters that may arise during the contract term.
- 2. All other terms and conditions of the contract shall remain the same.
- 3. This contract amendment is made in accordance with the professional services exception to public bidding in the Local Public Contracts Law (N.J.S.A. 40A:11-5(1)(a)(i)), and pursuant to the non-fair and open procedures of the State Pay-to-Play Law (N.J.S.A. 19:44A-20.5) and is in compliance with City of Newark Executive Order on Pay-to-Play Reform, MEO-07-0001, effective March 31, 2007 and the Contractor Pay-to-Play Reform Ordinance, 6PSF-a, 080112.

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- 4. Pursuant to N.J.A.C. 5:30-5.5, attached hereto is a partial certification of funds from the Chief Financial Officer which states that funds in the amount of \$35,000.00 are available in the 2013 Budget under Business Unit:\_NW011\_, Department ID:\_040\_, Account:\_71260\_. The certification of funds shall be filed along with the original resolution in the Office of the City Clerk.
- 5. A copy of the executed agreement herein authorized shall be filed in the Office of the City Clerk by the Corporation Counsel and shall be made available for public inspection.
- 6. A notice of this action shall be published in the newspaper authorized by law to publish a legal advertisement and as required by law within ten (10) days of the adoption of this resolution.

## **STATEMENT**

This resolution ratifies and authorizes the Mayor and/or his designee, the Corporation Counsel, to enter into and execute an Amended Contract for legal services concerning Litigation Defense Matters with Hardin, Kundla, McKeon & Poletto, 673 Morris Avenue, Springfield, New Jersey 07081-0730, as necessary for an additional \$35,000.00 which would result in a total amount not to exceed One Hundred Eighty-Five Thousand Dollars (\$185,000.00), for the period of January 1, 2013 through December 31, 2013.
