**WHEREAS**, an emergency has arisen in Special Item of Appropriation in the amount of \$89,113.00 for the Sexually Transmitted Diseases (STD) Program and no adequate provision has been made in the 2014 Temporary Budget for the aforesaid purpose and N.J.S.A. 40A: 4-20 provides for the creation of an emergency appropriation for the purpose above-mentioned; and

**WHEREAS**, by award letter dated December 11, 2013, from the New Jersey Department of Health, the City of Newark has been awarded \$89,113.00 to provide sexually transmitted diseases outreach educational services to include but limited to medical and laboratory services for residents within the City of Newark (City-wide); and

**WHEREAS**, N.J.S.A. 40A: 4-20 provides that the Governing Body by a two-thirds vote may make temporary emergency appropriations for any purpose for which appropriations may lawfully be made for the period between the beginning of the current fiscal year and the date of the adoption of the budget for said year; and

**WHEREAS**, emergency appropriation adopted in 2014, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A: 4-20 including this resolution total..... \$2,999,910.00.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NEWARK, NEW JERSEY, THAT:**

1. A temporary emergency appropriation be and the same is hereby made for the following classification.
