WHEREAS, an emergency has arisen in the Special Item of Appropriation in the amount of \$473,374.00 for the Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant Program and no adequate provision has been made in the 2016 Temporary Budget for the aforesaid purpose and N.J.S.A. 40A:4-20 provides for the creation of an emergency appropriation for the purpose abovementioned; and

WHEREAS, by Resolution 7R11-a, dated January 6 2016, the City of Newark accepted the 2015 Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant (JAG) Program in the amount of \$473,374.00 to fund overtime initiatives for implementation of strategies to prevent and control crime; and

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 40A:4-20 provides that the Governing Body by a two-thirds vote may make temporary emergency appropriations for any purpose for which appropriations may lawfully be made for the period between the beginning of the current fiscal year and the date of the adoption of the budget for said year; and

WHEREAS, the emergency appropriations adopted in 2016 pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:4-20 including this resolution total \$102,938,250.61.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NEWARK, NEW JERSEY, THAT:

STATEMENT

This legislation establishes the emergency appropriation in the amount of \$473,374.00 for the 2015 EDWARD BYRNE MEMORIAL JUSTICE ASSISTANCE GRANT PROGRAM (JAG), funded by the United States Department of Justice, Bureau of Justice Assistance, for the implementation of strategies to prevent and control crime and enter into an agreement with the Municipalities of Essex.
