WHEREAS, Joseph Pastore, is bonded in the amount of One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00) by virtue of a surety bond.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NEWARK, NEW JERSEY, THAT:
