**WHEREAS**, an emergency has arisen in Special Item of Appropriation in the amount of \$1,861,819.00 for the Women, Infants, and Children (WIC) Program and no adequate provision has been made in the 2019 Temporary Budget for the aforesaid purpose and N.J.S.A. 40A:4-20 provides for the creation of an emergency appropriation for the purpose above-mentioned; and

**WHEREAS**, by letter dated September 18, 2018 from the New Jersey Department of Health, Division of Family Health Services, the City of Newark has been awarded \$1,861,819.00 to provide nutritional services, nutritional education, immunization screening and education, voter registration and family care enrollment through participation in New Jersey Department of Health and Senior Services' Women, Infants and Children (WIC) Program to the residents of Newark; and

**WHEREAS**, N.J.S.A. 40A:4-20 provides that the Governing Body by a two-thirds vote may make temporary emergency appropriations for any purpose for which appropriations may lawfully be made for the period between the beginning of the current fiscal year and the date of the adoption of the budget for said year; and

**WHEREAS**, emergency appropriation adopted in 2019, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:4-20 including this resolution total.....\$6,607,106.00.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NEWARK, NEW JERSEY, THAT:**

1. A temporary emergency appropriation be and the same is hereby made for the following classification.

2. Said temporary emergency appropriation shall be provided for in the 2019 budget.
3. A copy of this resolution shall be immediately filed with the Director of Local Government Services by the City Clerk of the City of Newark.
