WHEREAS, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:4-19, Municipal Council adopted Resolution the

7R1-b adopted on January 5, 2022 to provide funds for the period January 1, 2022 through March 31, 2022, Resolution 7R1-a(s) adopted on April 12, 2022 provide funds for the period April 1, 2022 through April 30, 2022 and Resolution 7R1-b adopted on May 5, 2022 to provide funds for the period May 1, 2022 through May 31, 2022, and Resolution 7R1-b adopted on July 13, 2022 to provide funds for the period June 1, 2022 through June 30, 2022 and Resolution 7R1-c adopted on July 13, 2022 to provide funds for the period July 1, 2022 through June 31, 2022 through July 31, 2022 until the adoption of the Operating Budget of the City of Newark, New Jersey; and

WHEREAS, additional appropriations will be required from August 1, 2022 through August 31, 2022 until the adoption of 2022 Operating Budget; and

WHEREAS, previous Resolutions authorizing prior emergency appropriations submitted for Municipal Council approval totaled \$350,831,319.23; and

WHEREAS, <u>N.J.S.A.</u> 40A:4-20 provides that the Governing Body by a two-thirds vote may make temporary emergency appropriations for any purpose for which appropriations may lawfully be made for the period between the beginning of the current fiscal year and the date of the adoption of the budget for said year; and

WHEREAS, TE #37 is to provide funds for the period of August 1, 2022 through August 31, 2022, until the adoption of the budget; and

WHEREAS, the emergency appropriations adopted in 2022, pursuant to <u>N.J.S.A</u> .:40A:4-20 including this Resolution total \$403,595,090.23.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NEWARK, NEW JERSEY, THAT:

1. The Governing Body by a two-thirds vote of its full membership hereby amends its temporary budget by making the following emergency temporary appropriations.

STATEMENT

This legislation establishes a temporary emergency appropriation to provide operating funds from August 1, 2022 through August 31, 2022, until the adoption of the 2022 Municipal Budget.
