**WHEARES**, the City's Department of Health and Community Wellness provides medical care services pursuant to and consistent with Health Care Program Statutes (Section 330 of Public Health Services Act: 42 U.S.C. § 254(b), Program Regulation (43 CFR part 51 and 42 CFR 56.201) for

Community and Migrant Health Centers and Grant Regulations (42 CFR part 74), Affordable Health Care Act; and

**WHEREAS**, the New Jersey Department of Health, Division of HIV, STD and TB Services has made grant funds available for the provision of such services; and

**WHEREAS**, on or about April 1, 2022, on behalf of the City of Newark (the "City"), the Director of the Department of Health and Community Wellness electronically filed an application to the New Jersey Department of Health, Division of HIV, STD and TB Services, P.O. Box 360, Trenton, New Jersey 08625-0363, requesting grant funding for the continued provision of health care services to the medically underserved populated areas, which includes the City of Newark (a copy of the application is attached hereto and made a part hereof); and

**WHEREAS**, as a result of this application, the City was awarded a grant in the amount of One Hundred Sixty-Eight Thousand Eight Hundred Fifty-One Dollars and Zero Cents (\$168,851.00) from the New Jersey Department of Health, Division of HIV, STD, and TB Services, for the continued provision of health care services to the medically underserved populated areas, which includes the City of Newark for the period of July 1, 2022 through June 30, 2023 (a copy of the Notice of Award is attached hereto and made a part hereof); and

**WHEREAS**, the Acting Director of the Department of Health and Community Wellness did subsequently, on behalf of the City of Newark, cause the appropriate electronic submission to be made necessary to accept the above-mentioned grant award; and

**WHEREAS**, the City recognizes that the New Jersey Department of Health, Division of HIV, STD and TB Services, may extend the time of the grant award and/or provide additional funds if made available; and

**WHEREAS**, the New Jersey Department of Health, Division of HIV, STD, and TB Services, may amend the grant to reflect the grant time extension and/or increase or decrease of additional funds if made available; and

**WHEREAS**, the City's Department of Health and Community Wellness, shall upon any such extension of time of the grant and or increase or decrease of additional funds, file an amending resolution reflecting the final term and award amount of the grant; and

**WHEREAS**, terms of this grant award may only be waived or amended by the parties duly authorized to execute the grant, subject to the approval of the Municipal Council by resolution.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NEWARK, NEW JERSEY, THAT:**

1. The Mayor of the City of Newark and/or his designee, the Director of the Department of Health and Community Wellness, are hereby authorized to submit an application to the New Jersey Department of Health, Division of HIV, STD and TB Services, Hubert H. Humphrey Building, P.O. Box 360, Trenton, New Jersey 08625-0363, requesting funding for the continued provision of health care services to the medically underserved populated areas, which includes the City of Newark.

2. The Municipal Council hereby ratifies its authorization of this application from the date of application submission to the date of adoption of this authorizing Resolution.
3. The grant award in the amount of One Hundred Sixty-Eight Thousand Eight Hundred Fifty-One Dollars and Zero Cents (\$168,851.00), from the New Jersey Department of Health, Division of HIV, STD, and TB Services is hereby accepted.
4. The Mayor of the City of Newark and/or his designee, the Acting Director of the Department of Health and Community Wellness, are hereby authorized to receive and expend the grant award for the continued provision of health care services to the medically underserved populated areas, which includes the City of Newark for the period commencing on July 1, 2022 and terminating on June 30, 2023.
5. The City's Department of Health and Community Wellness, shall upon any extension of time of the grant, and/or increase or decrease of additional funds, file an amending resolution reflecting the final time and award amount of the grant.
6. The Municipal Council hereby ratifies the acceptance of this grant award from the date the electronic acceptance was filed to the date of adoption of this authorizing Resolution.
7. No municipal matching funds are required for the receipt or acceptance of this grant award.
8. The Acting Director of the Department of Health and Community Wellness shall file a fully executed copy of the grant application and the grant award letter in the Office of the City Clerk.

### **STATEMENT**

This Resolution ratifies and authorizes the actions taken by the Mayor of the City of Newark and/or his designee, the Acting Director of Health and Community Wellness, to apply for and accept grant funds in the amount of \$168,851.00, from the New Jersey Department of Health, Division of HIV, STD, and TB Services, for the period of July 1, 2022 through June 30, 2023. No municipal matching funds are required for the receipt or acceptance of the grant funds.
