WHEREAS, an emergency has arisen in the Special Item of Appropriation in the amount of Twelve Thousand Nine Hundred Seventy-One Dollars and Zero Cents (\$12,971.00) for WIOA Data Reporting Analysis Allocation 2022-2023 and no provision has been made in the 2023 Temporary Budget for the aforesaid purpose and N.J.S.A. 40A:4-20 provides for the creation of an emergency appropriation for the purpose abovementioned; and

WHEREAS, by Resolution 7R2-g adopted on November 14, 2022, the City of Newark accepted funds for WIOA Data Reporting Analysis Allocation 2022-2023 in the amount of Twelve Thousand Nine Hundred Seventy-One Dollars and Zero Cents (\$12,971.00)from the New Jersey Department of Labor and Workforce Development, to provide funds for program operations; and

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 40A:4-20 provides that the Governing Body by a two-thirds vote may make temporary emergency appropriations for any purpose for which appropriations may lawfully be made for the period between the beginning of the current fiscal year and the date of the adoption of the budget for said year; and

WHEREAS, the emergency appropriations adopted in 2023 pursuant to <u>N.J.S.A</u>. 40A:4-20 including this Resolution total \$ 6,557,084.00.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NEWARK, NEW JERSEY, THAT:

1. An emergency appropriation be and the same is hereby made for the following classification:

- 2. Said emergency appropriation shall be provided for in the 2023 budget.
