**WHEREAS**, an emergency has arisen in Special Item of Appropriation in the amount of \$800,000.00 for FY2023 Safe Streets and Roads for All Grant and no adequate provision has been made in the 2025 Temporary Budget for the aforesaid purpose; and

**WHEREAS**, N.J.S.A. 40A:4-20 provides for the creation of an emergency appropriation for the purpose above-mentioned; and

**WHEREAS**, by award letter dated December 23, 2023, from the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA), the City of Newark was awarded funds in the amount of \$800,000.00, to provide for FY2023 Safe Streets and Roads for All Grant; and

**WHEREAS**, N.J.S.A 40A:4-20 provides that the Governing Body by a two-thirds vote may make temporary emergency appropriations for any purpose for which appropriations may lawfully be made for the period between the beginning of the current fiscal year and the date of the adoption of the budget for said year; and

**WHEREAS**, emergency appropriation adopted in 2025 pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:4-20 including this resolution total...\$10,591,728.46.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NEWARK, NEW JERSEY**, no less than two-thirds of all members thereof affirmatively concurring, that:

1. An emergency appropriation be and the same is hereby made for the following classification:

2. Said emergency appropriation shall be provided for in the 2025 budget.
