**WHEREAS**, an emergency has arisen in the Special Item of Appropriation in the amount of Forty- Three Thousand Seven Hundred Eighty-Seven Dollars and Zero Cents (\$43,787.00), for Public Health Emergency Preparedness LINCS program, and no adequate provision has been made in the 2026 Temporary Budget for the aforesaid purpose and N.J.S.A. 40A:4-20 provides for the creation of an emergency appropriation for the purpose above-mentioned; and

**WHEREAS**, by the Notice of Award dated September 22, 2025, the New Jersey Department of Health (“NJDOH”) awarded the City of Newark additional funds in the amount of Forty- Three Thousand Seven Hundred Eighty-Seven Dollars and Zero Cents (\$43,787.00). The aforementioned program will provide funds for the provision of health care and supportive services to the residents of the City of Newark; and

**WHEREAS**, N.J.S.A. 40A:4-20 provides that the Governing Body, by a two-thirds vote, may make temporary emergency appropriations for any purpose for which appropriations may lawfully be made for the period between the beginning of the current fiscal year and the date of the adoption of the budget for said year; and

**WHEREAS**, emergency appropriation adopted in 2026, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A: 4-20 including this Resolution total.....\$ 175,660,148.56.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NEWARK, NEW JERSEY, THAT:**

1. A temporary emergency appropriation be and the same is hereby made for the following classification.
