Whereas, Santiago B. Velazquez, was appointed as a Constable pursuant to Resolution 7R9-c adopted at the January 16, 2013, Regular Municipal Council meeting; and

Whereas, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:9-125, Santiago B. Velazquez, must give a bond within thirty (30) days of the initial adoption of the resolution of appointment, in such form and amount as prescribed by the Governing Body and approved as to form and legality by the Corporation Counsel; and

Whereas, the Municipal Council wishes to amend the term of appointment, in part due to the overdue receipt of the Bond and approve the form, amount and sufficiency of the Constable Bond.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NEWARK, NEW JERSEY, THAT:

1. The term of the Constable appointment of Santiago B. Velazquez is amended to three (3) years from the date of the adoption of this resolution or the expiration of the Constable Bond, whichever occurs first. Resolution 7R9-c, adopted on January 16, 2013, is hereby amended

accordingly.

2. The Constable Bond, in the amount of \$1000.00 issued to Santiago B. Velazquez, 241 Broome Street, Newark, New Jersey 07108, is approved as to form, amount and sufficiency.

Statement

The amended Resolution authorizes Santiago B. Velazquez, to serve as Constable in the City of Newark, New Jersey, for a term of three (3) years from the date of the adoption of this resolution or the expiration of the Constable, whichever occurs first; and the Constable Bond is approved as to form, amount and sufficiency.
