### **Legislation Text**

#### TE-#7

Two-Thirds vote of full membership required.

WHEREAS, an emergency has arisen in Special Item of Appropriation in the amount of \$1.575.460.00, for the Urban Areas Security Initiative Grant and no adequate provision has been made in the 2014 Temporary Budget for the aforesaid purpose and N.J.S.A. 40A: 4-20 provides for the creation of an emergency appropriation for the purpose above-mentioned; and

WHEREAS, by authorizing Resolution 7R1-i dated December 4, 2013, the City of Newark accepted funds for the Urban Areas Security Initiative Grant from the State of New Jersey Office of Homeland Security and Preparedness in the amount of \$1,575,460.00 to provide region's ability to build, maintain and sustain national preparedness capabilities related to training, maintenance, emergency notification system within the City of Newark (City-wide); and

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 40A: 4-20 provides that the Governing Body by a two-thirds vote may make temporary emergency appropriations for any purpose for which appropriations may lawfully be made for the period between the beginning of the current fiscal year and the date of the adoption of the budget for said year; and

WHEREAS, the emergency appropriations adopted in 2014, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A: 4-20 including this resolution total......\$7,365,935.00.
