WHEREAS, an emergency has arisen in Special Item of Appropriation in the amount of \$548,578.00, for the Emergency Solutions Grant (ESG) to provide homeless prevention, rapid rehousing, utilities and homeless assistance to residents within the City of Newark; and no adequate provision has been made in the 2015 Temporary Budget for the aforesaid purpose and N.J.S.A. 40A: 4-20 provides for the creation of an emergency appropriation for the purpose above-mentioned; and

WHEREAS, by Resolution 7R1-k dated January 7, 2015, the City of Newark accepted funds for the ESG Program from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) in the amount of \$548,578.00 to provide homeless prevention, rapid rehousing, utilities and homeless assistance to residents within the City of Newark; and

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 40A: 4-20 provides that the Governing Body by a two-thirds vote may make temporary emergency appropriations for any purpose for which appropriations may lawfully be made for the period between the beginning of the current fiscal year and the date of the adoption of the budget for said year; and

WHEREAS, emergency appropriation adopted in 2015, pursuant to <u>N.J.S.A.</u> 40A: 4-20 including this resolution total......\$617,489.00
