**WHEREAS**, N.J.S.A 40A:4-87 provides that the Director of Local Government Services may approve the insertion of any Special Item of Revenue in the budget of any local unit when such item shall have been made available by law and the amount thereof shall not have been determined at the time of the adoption of the budget, and may approve the insertion of an appropriation item of equal amount for the purpose of carrying out the purposes of the law making such item of revenue available for expenditure; and

Operating Agency: Department of Health and Community Wellness

Two-Thirds vote of full membership required.

**WHEREAS,** the United States Department of Health and Human Services, Health Resources and Services Administration (HRSA) has made available \$7,261,867.00 for the HIV Emergency Relief Grant; and

**WHEREAS,** by an award letter dated September 7, 2018 from the United States Department of Health and Human Services, Health Resources and Services Administration (HRSA), authorizing an estimate of the total formula award of \$7,261,867.00, the City of Newark accepted the HIV Emergency Relief Grant to provide Ryan White HIV/AIDS related health and support services to the Newark Eligible Metropolitan Area.

# NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NEWARK, NEW JERSEY, THAT:

1. In accordance with the provisions of N.J.S.A 40A:4-87, the City of Newark, New Jersey, hereby

requests the Director of Local Government Services to approve a budget insertion in the amount of \$7,261,867.00 and an appropriation of an equal amount for the HIV Emergency Relief Grant in the budget year 2018 as set forth in Schedule A, attached hereto and made a part hereof.

- 2. The aforesaid insertion is, in the opinion of the Governing Body, warranted and authorized by N.J.S.A. 40A:4-87 and is necessary for the orderly operation of the municipality.
