Legislation Text

TE - #30

Two-thirds vote of full membership required.

WHEREAS, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:4-19, the Municipal Council of the City of Newark adopted Resolution 7R1-f(as) dated January 9, 2019 to provide funds for the period January 1, 2019 through March 31, 2019, 7R1-c was adopted on March 20, 2019 to provide funds for the period April 1, 2019 through April 30, 2019, 7R1-c was adopted on April 17, 2019 to provide funds for the period May 1, 2019 through May 31, 2019, and 7R1-c adopted June 6, 2019 to provide funds for the period of June 1, 2019 through June 30, 2019; and 7R1-c adopted July 10 2019, to provide funds for the period July 1, 2019 through July 31, 2019, until the adoption of the Operating Budget of the City of Newark, New Jersey; and

WHEREAS, additional appropriations will be required from August 1, 2019 through August 31, 2019 until the adoption of 2019 Operating Budget; and

WHEREAS, prior emergency appropriations submitted for Municipal Council approval totaled \$307,684,054.73; and

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 40A:4-20 provides that the Governing Body, by a two-thirds vote, may make temporary emergency appropriations for any purpose for which appropriations may lawfully be made for the period between the beginning of the current fiscal year and the date of the adoption of the budget for said year; and

WHEREAS, TE #30 is to provide funds for the period of August 1, 2019 through August 31, 2019, until the adoption of the budget; and

WHEREAS, the emergency appropriations adopted in 2019 pursuant to <u>N.J.S.A.</u> 40A:4-20 including this resolution total......\$361,015,211.73

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NEWARK, NEW JERSEY, THAT:
