WHEREAS, pursuant to <u>N.J.S.A.</u> 40A:4-19 the Municipal Council of the City of Newark adopted resolution 7R1-A dated January 22, 2020 to provide funds for the period January 1, 2020 to March 31, 2020 until the adoption of the Operating Budget of the City of Newark, New Jersey; and

WHEREAS, additional appropriations will be required from January 1, 2020 to March 31, 2020, until the adoption of the budget; and

WHEREAS, <u>N.J.S.A.</u> 40A:4-20 provides that the Governing Body, by a two-thirds vote, may make Temporary Emergency Appropriations for any purpose for which appropriations may lawfully be made for the period between the beginning of the current fiscal year and the date of the adoption of the budget for said year; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NEWARK, NEW JERSEY, THAT:

1. The Governing Body, by a two-thirds vote of its full membership, hereby amends its temporary budget by making the following emergency temporary appropriations:
