AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 23:7-1, PARKING METER REGULATION, GENERALLY, TITLE 23, TRAFFIC, OF THE REVISED GENERAL ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF NEWARK, NEW JERSEY, 2000, AS AMENDED AND SUPPLEMENTED, BY EXTENDING THE TIME LIMITS ON PARKING AND STREET PARKING BOUNDARIES.

WHEREAS, the Department of Engineering, Division of Traffic and Signals and the Newark Parking Authority desires to extend the time limits on parking and street parking boundaries (affecting all City Wards); and

WHEREAS, the parking time limit will be increased to allow motorists to park for an extended period of time on certain streets throughout the City; and

WHEREAS, the street parking boundaries are being extended in Chapter 7 to allow for more meter parking and to cover areas that are highly congested that do not allow for an efficient turnaround in the parking availability, due to the fact that there are no meters regulating the time limit on parking; and

WHEREAS, some of the changes made in this Ordinance will replace sections of R.O. 23:5-4 and R.O. 24:5-5 in order to have the street boundaries and hours of parking in one ordinance to make it easier for the Parking Attendants, Police Officers, and Citizens to know the regulations.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NEWARK, THAT:

Section 1. That Section 23:7-3.1, Parking Limited to Eight (8) Hours 9:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. Except Sunday, Chapter 23:7, Parking Meter Regulations, Generally, of Title 23, Traffic and Parking, of the General Ordinances of the City of Newark, New Jersey, 2000, as amended and supplemented, be amended to change the name of the section, to extend the parking hours, and add additional streets to this section as follows:

23:7-3.1. Parking Limited to **<u>Eight</u>** 8 Hours <u>**7:00 a.m.**</u> 9:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. <u>**10:00 p.m.**</u> Except Sunday.

No person shall park any vehicle upon any of the following streets, portions of streets or designated points for longer than eight (8) hours between the hours specified:

a. Bergen Street from South Orange Avenue to West Market Street.

- b. <u>Division Street, both sides between Broad Street and McCarter Highway.</u>
- c. <u>Grant Street, both sides between 8th Avenue and Broad Street.</u>
- d. <u>Orange Street, both sides between Broad Street and Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. Boulevard.</u>
- e. State Street, both side between University Avenue and Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. Boulevard.

Section 2. That Section 23:7-3.2, Parking Limited to Four (4) Hours 9:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. Except Sunday., Chapter 23:7, Parking Meter Regulations, Generally, of Title 23, Traffic and Parking, of the General Ordinances of the City of Newark, New Jersey, 2000, as amended and supplemented, be amended to change the name of the section, to extend the parking hours, and add additional streets to this section as follows:

23:7-3.2. Parking Limited to Four (4) Hours **7:00 a.m.** 9:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. **9:00 p.m.** Except Sunday.

No person shall park any vehicle upon any of the following streets, portions of streets or designated points for longer than four (4) hours between the hours specified:

- a. 12th Avenue, from West Market Street to Bergen Street, both sides.
- b. West Market Street, from <u>Martin Luther King, Jr. Boulevard</u> University Avenue to Wickcliff Street Norfolk Street, both sides.
- c. Martin Luther King, Jr. Boulevard, from West Market Street to Central Avenue Crane Street, both sides.
- d. University Avenue, from Central Avenue Orange Street to West Market Street, both sides.
- e. Washington Street, from Raymond Boulevard to James Street Broad Street, both sides.
- f. Warren Street, from Halsey Street to Lock Street, both sides.
- g. New Street, from Halsey Street to Washington Street Norfolk Street, both sides.
- h. Bleeker Street, from Halsey Street to University Avenue Summit Street, both sides.
- Lock Street, from Warren Street to New Street, both sides.
- j. Central Avenue, from Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. Boulevard to Norfolk Street.
 - 1. South side, from 9:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.
 - 2. North side, from 7:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.
- k. Ferry Street, from Raymond Plaza East to Fleming Avenue. Both sides, Ord. 6 PSF-H, 12 -21-10)
- I. Market Street, from University Avenue to Martin L. King, Jr. Boulevard, north side.

m. Newark Street, from Central Ave to Warren Street, both sides.

Section 3. That Section 23:7-3.3, Parking Limited to Two (2) Hours 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. Except Sunday., Chapter 23:7, Parking Meter Regulations, Generally, of Title 23, Traffic and Parking, of the General Ordinances of the City of Newark, New Jersey, 2000, as amended and supplemented, be amended by adding additional streets to this section as follows:

23:7-3.3. Parking Limited to Two (2) Hours 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. Except Sunday.

No person shall park any vehicle upon any of the following streets, portions of streets or designated points for longer than two (2) hours between the hours specified:

- a. Bloomfield Avenue from Broadway to Bloomfield City line, both sides.
- b. Branch Brook Place, from Grafton Avenue to Montclair Avenue both sides, except Sunday.
- c. Broad Street, from Lackawanna Avenue to South Street Poinier Street, both sides.
- d. Central Avenue, from Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. Boulevard to Lock Street, both sides.
 - a. South side, from 9:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.
- e. Franklin Avenue, from Heller Parkway to Belleville City line, both sides.
- f. Heller Parkway, from Forest Hill Parkway to Lake Street, both sides.
- g. Market Street, from 13th Avenue University Avenue to Mulberry Street, both sides.
- h. Norman Road, from Woodbine Avenue to Mount Vernon Place, both sides, except Sunday.
- i. Oakland Terrace, from South Orange Avenue to Cliff Street, both sides, except Sunday.
- j. Poe Avenue, from South Orange Avenue to Marion Avenue, both sides, except Sunday.
- k. Reynolds Place, from Woodbine Avenue to terminus, both sides, except Sunday.
- I. Richelieu Terrace, from South Orange Avenue to Cliff Street, both sides, except Sundays.
- m. South Orange Avenue, from Springfield Avenue to Grand Avenue, north side.
- n. South Orange Avenue, from Halsted Street to South Orange Village Line, north side.
- South Orange Avenue, from Dover Street to Springfield Avenue, South side.

Springfield Avenue, from William Street Market Street to University Avenue South 19th Street, both sides.

- a. North side, from 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.
- p. St. Paul Avenue, from South Orange Avenue to Cliff Street, both sides, except Sundays.

- q. Synott Place, from Woodbine Avenue to terminus, both sides, except Sundays.
- r. <u>Tuxedo Parkway, from Woodbine Avenue to Mount Vernon Place, both sides, except Sundays.</u>
- s. University Avenue, from Market Street to Court Street, both sides.
- t. Woodbine Avenue, from Eastern Parkway to South Orange Village Line.
 - a. Both sides, from 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.

Section 4. That Section 23:7-3.4, Parking Limited to Two (2) Hours 9:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m., Except Sunday., Chapter 23:7, Parking Meter Regulations, Generally, of Title 23, Traffic and Parking, of the General Ordinances of the City of Newark, New Jersey, 2000, as amended and supplemented, be amended by adding additional streets to this section as follows:

23:7-3.4. Parking Limited to Two (2) Hours 9:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. Except Sunday.

No person shall park any vehicle upon any of the following streets, portions of streets or designated points for longer than two (2) hours between the hours specified:

- a. Academy Street, from Halsey Street to University Avenue, north side.
- b. Bank Street, from Halsey Street to University Avenue, both sides.
- c. <u>Bergen Street, from Nye Avenue to Weequahic Avenue</u>
 - a. Both sides, from 9:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.
- d. Bloomfield Avenue, from Broadway to Bloomfield Town Line
 - a. North side, from 7:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.
 - b. South side, from 9:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.
- e. Bloomfield Place, from Broad Street to Broadway.
- f. Branford Place, from Springfield Avenue to Broad Street, both sides.
- g. Broad Street, from Clay Street to Harvey Street, both sides.

- z. Halsey Street, from Central Avenue Washington Place to Hill Street, both sides.
- aa. Hill Street, from Broad Street to Washington Street, both sides.
- bb. Hoyt Street from Central Avenue to Sussex Avenue, both sides.
- cc. James Street, from University Avenue to Washington Street, both sides.
- dd. Lincoln Park, from Broad Street to Clinton Avenue, both sides.
- ee. Lombardy Street, from McCarter Highway to Broad Street, both sides.
- ff. Mount Prospect Avenue, from Elwood Avenue to Heller Parkway, both sides.
- gg. New Street, from Broad Street to Halsey Street, both sides.
- hh. Park Place, from Raymond Boulevard to Sarah Vaughan Way, both sides.
- ii. Sussex Avenue from Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. Boulevard to Colden Street, both sides.
- ij. Washington Place, from Broad Street to Washington Street, both sides.

kk. William Street, from Broad Street to Washington Street, both sides.

Section 5. That Section 23:7-16, Special Events Parking, Chapter 23:7, Parking Meter Regulations, Generally, of Title 23, Traffic and Parking, of the General Ordinances of the City of Newark, New Jersey, 2000, as amended and supplemented, be amended to change the name of the section, to extend the parking hours, and add additional streets to this section as follows: 23:7-16. SPECIAL EVENTS PARKING.

- a. For purposes of this chapter, a special event is any event which is held at any of the venues listed in Parking Zones 4 where the general public is invited to attend and a fee is charged for admission. The following streets or portions thereof in Zone 4 are areas designated by the City which are subject to the Special Event Parking Rate in addition to any regular rate as may be set forth in Section 23:7-13, above: both sides of the following streets or portions thereof are intended unless otherwise specifically set forth:
- 1. Chestnut Street, both sides between Jefferson Street and New Jersey Railroad Avenue.
- 2. Chestnut Street, north side between Mulberry Street and Orchard Street.
- 3. Lincoln Park, both sides between Broad Street and Clinton Avenue.
- 4. Clinton Avenue, both sides between Lincoln Park and Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. Boulevard.
- 5. Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. Boulevard, both sides, between Clinton Avenue and State Street.
- 6. Division Street, both sides between Broad Street and McCarter Highway.
- 7. Mulberry Street, east side between East Park Street and Raymond Boulevard.
- 8. Mulberry Street, west side between Raymond Boulevard and Market Street.
- 9. Mulberry Street, both sides between Franklin Street and East Kinney Street.
- 10. Market Street, both sides between Mulberry Street and Broad Street.
- 11. East Park Street, both sides between Mulberry Street and Park Place.
- 12. Green Street, both sides between Mulberry Street Liberty Street and Broad Street.
- 13. Commerce Street, both sides between Broad Street and McCarter Highway.
- 14. Commerce Court, east side between Raymond Boulevard and Commerce Street.
- 15. Broad Street, west side between Branford Place and William Street.
- 16. Broad Street, both sides between Lafayette Street and Lincoln Park.
- 17. William Street, both sides between Broad Street and Washington Street.
- 18. Hill Street, both sides between Broad Street and Washington Street.
- 19. State Street, north side between University Avenue and Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. Boulevard.
- 20. Orange Street, both sides between Broad Street and Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. Boulevard.
- 21. Park Place, both sides between Raymond Boulevard to Sarah Vaughan Way (16A), both sides.
- 22. Rector Street, both sides between Broad Street to McCarter Highway.
- **Section 6.** Any existing ordinances or parts thereof inconsistent with this Ordinance are hereby repealed.
- **Section 7. Severability.** If any provision of this amendment shall be deemed unenforceable by a court of competent jurisdiction, the remainder of the amendment shall remain in full force and effect.
- **Section 8.** This Ordinance does not require approval by the Commissioner of Transportation.
- **Section 9.** This Ordinance shall take effect upon final passage and publication in accordance with the laws of the State of New Jersey.

STATEMENT

This Ordinance extends the time limits on parking and the street parking boundaries (affecting all City Wards), for Section 23:7-1 et. seq., Parking Meter Regulations, Generally, of Title 23, Traffic, of the Revised General Ordinances of the City of Newark, New Jersey 2000.
