WHEREAS, an emergency has arisen in Special Item of Appropriation in the amount of Ten Thousand Five Hundred Dollars and Zero Cents (\$10,500.00) from the New Jersey Division of Highway Traffic Safety (DHTS) and no provision has been made in the 2026 Temporary Budget for the aforesaid purpose and N.J.S.A. 40A:4-20 provides for the creation of an emergency appropriation for the purpose above-mentioned; and

WHEREAS, by Legistar 7R9-c adopted December 17, 2025 (25-1554), the City of Newark accepted FY 2025 Drive Sober or Get Pulled Over Grant in the amount of Ten Thousand Five Hundred Dollars and Zero Cents (\$10,500.00) to fund the address traffic concerns; and

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 40A:4-20 provides that the Governing Body by a two-thirds vote may make temporary emergency appropriations for any purpose for which appropriations may lawfully be made for the period between the beginning of the current fiscal year and the date of the adoption of the budget for said year; and

WHEREAS, emergency appropriation adopted in 2026 pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:4-20 including this resolution total.....\$483,815.00.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NEWARK, NEW JERSEY, THAT:

1. A temporary emergency appropriation be and the same is hereby made for the following classification.
